Sandy Oaks Campground boasts beautiful grounds with ride on/ride off access to Big River State Forest equestrian trails and a 50-acre dirt bike and ATV riding park.

We have 100 sites with 30 and 50 amp hook ups, picnic table, fire ring and water spigots which are located throughout the camp. Our sites offer pull in, back in or pull through parking. Also, centrally located in the camp is a playground with swings, a slide, monkey bars and more! There is a dump station near the dumpster to use at the end of your stay. Ice and wood are available for purchase. Check in time is 2:00PM, check out time is 11:00AM. You are allowed to stay longer if your site is not reserved for the following night. Please contact the camp host if you wish to check out later.

Sandy Oaks offers a remodeled shower house centrally located in the campground and a clubhouse equipped with men's and women's restrooms with showers, a kitchen, 2 bedrooms and a general leisure area with tables and couches. You may rent the kitchen and two bedrooms for \$100 per night.

The town of Keithsburg is a 10-minute drive north from camp with Casey's General Store and Eagles Nest Sports Grill. The town of Oquawka is a 12-minute drive south with Fisher Foods Grocery, Subway, Mama's Place Restaurant and Lucky's Bar B Q, a coffee shop, gas stations and more.

You and your horse, donkey, mule or pony will ride off of Sandy Oaks Campground from the southwest end of the property directly into the Big River State Forest. The land was first acquired in 1925 as only a 200-acre refuge, but subsequent land purchases raised the total to 2,900 acres. The B.R.S.F. boats over 8 miles of beautiful, all-weather, sand trails and large, mature trees. You may encounter the wild life here such as deer, turkey, rabbits and squirrels. Please be respectful of the state forest by staying on the designated trails, pack out what you pack in, take photos and memories but leave only hoof prints!

Sandy Oaks is also home to America's toughest motocross track! In 1977, Sandy Oaks Raceway hosted a 125cc National Pro Motocross race where Bob Hannah, Broc Glover and other big names remember Sandy Oaks as "the toughest track ever". On the 50-acre park, you'll find the notorious national motocross track, an open riding area and miles of trails. The park has a designated and arrowed kids track where ONLY 50cc and 65cc bikes are allowed. You must sign a waiver and pay a daily ride fee of \$10 (cash only) at the club house right inside the door. Failure to do so will result in trespassing. Day riders must park in the back near the machine shed.

Pricing:

Camping per night \$25 Dirt Bike / ATV park \$10 per day Clubhouse Rental \$100 per night

Horses are allowed to be tied to high line.

Rules:

We've established the following general campground guidelines to help ensure your safety and your enjoyment, while in our park and the same to our other guests. Those who choose not to observe these guidelines can be asked to leave our park without any form of refund.

Campground Connections:

a. Electric: We do not allow 'pig tail' or 'dog bone' adapters from 50 amp to a 30 amp. You must plug in to appropriate receptacle that matches the hard wiring of your RV.

b. Sewer: Ground disposal of any drain water (gray or black) is prohibited by State Law. Wastewater from RVs (including sink water) must be disposed of into sewer drains. Do not put grease down the sewer.

Visitors:

- a. The only RV, vehicles, and occupants allowed to stay at Guest's site are those registered with the office.
- b. Rates are for 2 adults and 2 children per site; Each additional person is \$5 per day.
- c. Guest is responsible for the conduct of their visitors and shall be personally liable for any injuries or property damage caused by or arising from the actions of said visitor.

Children: Parents are responsible for the behavior and welfare of their children at all times. Parents must supervise children when using any campground facilities. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult in the bathrooms, clubhouse, and playground. Anyone under 18 years old riding the dirt bike / ATV park MUST be under the direct supervision of their parent or legal guardian at all times.

Pets: Pets must be kept on a leash and are not to be left unattended at your campsite. No pet pens allowed. Pet owner shall pick up and properly dispose of pet's waste. If our staff observes you not cleaning up after your pet, you will be fined a minimum \$100. Excessive barking or aggressive pets will not be tolerated. Violation of the pet policy can result in termination of your stay at Sandy Oaks Campground and no refund of any payments will be issued.

Sandy Oaks Campground is pet friendly and welcomes campers who travel and share their camping experience with their pets. However, to insure all of our guests have a safe and enjoyable time, it is important that you read and abide by the following pet policy. Pets are welcome but their owners must be well behaved!

- 1. Guest(s) may bring usual household pets such as dogs and cats. No other animals, livestock, poultry, reptiles, insects, or exotic pets are permitted.
- 2. 2 pet limit; no exceptions
- 3. Your pet must be kept on a non-retractable leash of 6 feet or shorter whenever they're outside your vehicle, RV AND in the control of their owner. Persons, including children, who are unable to control their pets must remove them from Sandy Oaks Campground, or the animal may be taken to/by local animal control authorities.
- 4. Pets are not to be left tethered outside without the owner present. If the dog is tethered outside; the lead or leash should not exceed 6 feet long. No dog pens, fences, cages, etc allowed on site.
- 5. All dogs must have current vaccinations and rabies registration. Documentation must be readily available. Pets should be collared and have an identifying tag.
- 7. No excessive barking (consistently barking for longer than 5 minutes).
- 8. Pick up after your pet. Not picking up after your pet is reason to be asked to leave the campground; and/or you may be assessed a \$50 fine per offense.

- 9. For the protection of, and in consideration to other persons, noisy, aggressive, unfriendly, vicious, unruly, or poisonous pets are not allowed at Sandy Oaks Campground. Dogs must react politely to other dogs and to distractions. We do not accept any dog having a history of aggression, biting, or unfriendly behavior to other dogs and/or humans. If your dog shows behavior that is protective and unfriendly to strangers, please leave it home. If you decide to bring your dog and it exhibits this type of behavior the camp host will ask you to find other camping accommodations.
- 10. Service dogs are welcome. They are subject to the same policies as non-service animals.

Sandy Oaks Campground owners and affiliates shall be held harmless and assume no responsibility, implied or otherwise, for dog bites or any pet related injuries. The owner of any pet is responsible for any injuries or damages caused by their pets. In addition, the owner of any pet that causes injury or damages to another is expected to resolve the issue directly with the injured party. Violation of these guidelines can result in the guest being asked to leave the park without a refund.

Vehicles:

Two vehicles are allowed per site.

Speed Limit:

Please observe our 5 mph speed limit to insure the safety of all our guests.

Remember...people are walking pets and children are playing!

Quiet Time:

Be considerate of your neighbors. Keep noise levels down to a minimum (between 10:00PM to 8:00AM.) No loud trucks, cars, or generators.

Standard of Appearance:

- a. Campsite shall remain neat and orderly at all times.
- b. Site must remain free from trash, debris and unused items.
- c. Place all bagged, household garbage in designated dumpster located near dump station.
- d. Do not cut trees or branches, add or remove any landscaping, etc.
- e. Only lawn furniture outside
- f. No stakes/poles in the ground. No digging.
- g. Vehicle/camper washing requires \$20 permit from office for water usage.

Drug use:

Drug-related criminal activity engaged in, on or near the premises by Guest or visitor of Guest, or such activity engaged in on the premises is grounds for immediate eviction.

Alcohol:

No public intoxication. No open containers in public areas. Consumption limited to campsites. Violation of the alcohol policy can result in termination of your stay at Sandy Oaks Campground and no refund of any payments will be issued.

Fireworks and Firearms:

Prohibited on park property including BB, airsoft, paintball and pellet guns.

Campfires: Because you can endanger those around you, this is one of the most important camping rules.

Campfires in designated fire rings only. Be sure to put out your campfire before bed, before heading out for the day, or when you leave. No firepits or grills on picnic tables.

Liability:

The use of Sandy Oaks Campground facilities is at the user's own risk. Guests are responsible for their visitors. Sandy Oaks Campground assumes no responsibility or liability for the safety and security of RV tenants/campground guests/visitors. Sandy Oaks Campground is not responsible for loss or damage to Guests' property due to theft, vandalism, fire, any casualty, or act of God. Registered guests and all other users of this property expressly assume all risk of such loss or damage and must carry their own insurance for their RV and vehicles.
